## MRL PAC RELEASES AUGUST 6, 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION ENDORSEMENTS

Today, Missouri Right to Life Political Action Committees (MRL PAC) released its list of endorsed candidates for Missouri's August 6, 2024 Primary Election.

- From the second Tuesday before an election to the day before the election, you may vote a no-excuse absentee ballot in person at a location designated by your local election authority.
