## 10 Reasons to SUPPORT Amendment 3 in 2026

### 1 2026 Amendment 3

Authorizes the General Assembly to enact regulatory laws that ensure the health and safety of pregnant women.

### 2 2026 Amendment 3

Specifies that an abortion may not be performed on a minor under 18 years in age (and not emancipated) without her written consent and the written consent of one parent, or in the alternative, a court order. Such consents would not be required in a medical emergency.

### 3 2026 Amendment 3

Recognizes that any woman is entitled to refuse a demand, request, or recommendation to obtain an abortion. Consent must be voluntary as well as informed.

### 4 2026 Amendment 3

Provides that access to medical care in cases of miscarriage, ectopic pregnancy, and other medical emergencies shall not be infringed by the State.

### 5 2026 Amendment 3

Protects children under 18 years of age from gender transition surgeries and cross-sex hormones or puberty-blocking drugs. Exceptions are made for treatment of sexual and other disorders unrelated to so-called gender transitions.

### 6 2026 Amendment 3

Promotes the basic dignity of human remains by barring the harvesting of fetal organs as defined in the Amendment.

### 7 2026 Amendment 3

Protects against a recommendation of abortion based on indications of disability in an unborn child, except when a fetal anomaly is indicated that would make life outside the womb to be impossible.

### 8 2026 Amendment 3

Would reinforce the principle that a woman may seek damages and other relief from any other person who coerces her or attempts to coerce her to obtain an abortion.

### 9 2026 Amendment 3

Allows the General Assembly to require that abortions can only be performed or prescribed by a licensed physician.

### 10 2026 Amendment 3

Abrogates language in the Missouri Constitution that could endanger a woman's right to sue medical practitioners for professional malpractice.
